The Queensland Premier recently released the EPA's new zoning plan of **Moreton Bay Marine Park**. The current zoning plan remains in effect, and the new zoning plan will be effective from 1 March 2009.

The AFAQ submitted its response earlier this year. Our main concern was with the original proposal of limited line fishing in the Bribie passage, Zone CPZ02, of one hook one line per angler. The EPA has reviewed this and will now be "up to 2 lines and a maximum of 2 hooks pre angler".
