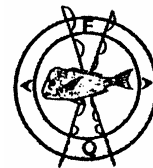

Synoptic Situation: A large 1041hPa high east of Tasmania and a trough off the tropical east coast have combined to produce a strong pressure gradient over the Southeast Queensland Coast. This is generating **gale force winds** and a gale warning is current for coastal waters between Sandy Cape and Coolangatta.

Large waves have developed overnight north of the Gold Coast. Conditions are more moderate on the Gold Coast.

The State Emergency Service advises that people in the affected area should **stay clear of the water** in the open ocean as **large waves** and rip currents develop.
